\* CALL TO WORSHIP

Romans 13:11-12

### PRAYER OF CONFESSION

We confess our eagerness to grasp your offer of redeeming love but also our resistance to follow you without question. In this Advent time, forgive us our failure to respond as we should. Come to us anew, and by your grace, assist us to receive you with joy, as the shepherds; with gratitude, as Simeon; with obedience, as Mary; with love, as you have loved us. Even so: come, Lord Jesus. (Silent Confession) Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDONING GRACE Psalm 85:9-13 God declares that all who repent and believe in Jesus Christ are completely forgiven from the guilt and shame of all their sins.

Surely God's salvation is at hand for those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land. Steadfast love and faithfulness will meet; righteousness and peace will kiss each other. Faithfulness will spring up from the ground, and righteousness will look down from the sky. The Lord will give what is good, and our land will yield its increase. Reflections on Genesis 3:15

The First Promise of Christmas

Because God is in control, nothing could prevent the birth of that promised head-crusher of the serpent, Jesus of Nazareth.
